

# Making a sockasaurus dinosaur puppet

## Equipment

- clean sock
- felt
- two googly eyes
- small plastic bottle
- needle and thread
- buttons
- scissors
- glue



## Method

- 1 Place the sock on your hand and wiggle it around, so your thumb and fingers make a mouth shape for your puppet. This will give you an idea of where to place the eyes, nose, tongue and spikes on your puppet.
- 2 Take the puppet off your hand and lay it flat on the table.
- 3 Cut out some coloured felt to make a tongue for your dinosaur. Sew or glue it onto the toe of the sock.
- 4 Glue two googly eyes onto the sock, so they will sit on top of your hand when you use the puppet.
- 5 Sew on a button for a nose.
- 6 Cut triangles out of coloured felt to make spikes along your puppet's back. Glue or sew these into place.
- 7 Slip your puppet over a small plastic bottle to allow the glue to dry. While it is on the bottle, you might like to add more patterns or dino features!
