It looks like the weekend and people are out shopping because of the clothes and shopping bags. It looks like dusk at winter because of the low sun and people are dressed warmly. The roads are closed to cars.</p>
	<p>A little girl sitting on a wooden grey chair in front of a large number one.</p>	<p>I think it is her first birthday because she looks young and is dressed in pretty clothes. There is bunting hanging up which suggests a celebration and the large number one is part of the decoration.</p>
	<p>I can see two firefighters with a hose and a burnt-out bus.</p>	<p>The firefighters are successfully putting out the fire on the bus. The fire must have been very bad as it has completely destroyed the bus. It looks like the firefighters are from a different country because of how they are dressed.</p>
	<p>A happy lady is throwing coloured powder in a street scene.</p>	<p>It looks like the Holi festival which is a spring festival originally from India. The people are happy and having fun because they are smiling and laughing.</p>
