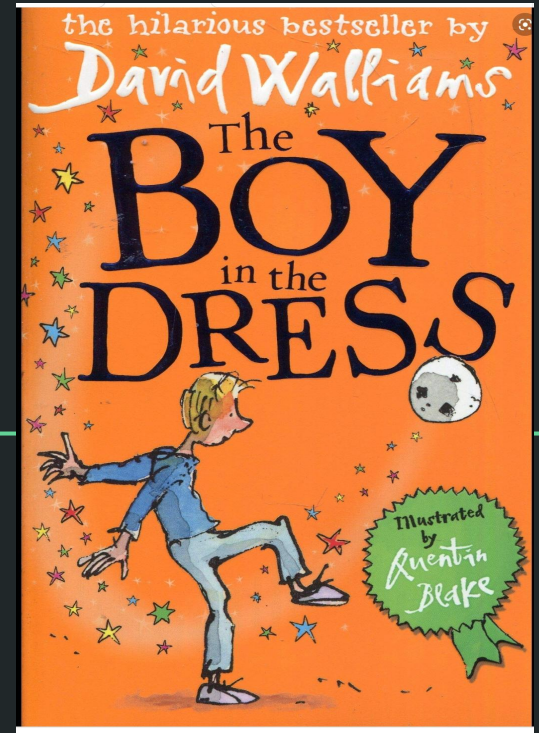


The boy in the dress

Lisa is a wonderful, kind girl. She ask Dennis to walk her home from school and she asked Dennis if he can come over for the weekend.



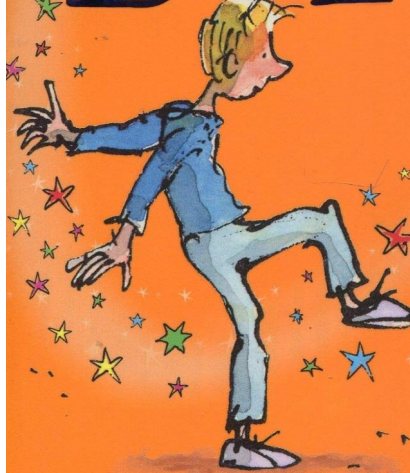
Why do you like this book?
